The Glasgow City Council

(School Streets, Glasgow) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles)(Traffic Regulation) Order 2024

Glasgow City Council proposes to consider the introduction of the above named Traffic Regulation Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

The Temporary Traffic Regulation Order which covers Phase 5 of the School Streets project expires in 2024, and the Council now proposes to make this Order permanent.

The permanent TRO would continue to improve road safety on the undernoted roads by reducing congestion and minimising the number of vehicles permitted to travel on these roads at the beginning and end of the school day.

The list of roads affected by these proposals are:

- · Blackfriars Primary School Camden Terrace
- Corpus Christi Primary School Pikeman Road
- · St Marnock's Primary School Langton Crescent

Details of the proposals are as follows:

The proposed Order will comprise of:

• Prohibiting of driving on the above roads for a period of time during the peak school drop off and pick up times, Monday to Friday, except for permitted vehicles. The restrictions are in place at Blackfriars Primary School and St Marnock's Primary School between the hours of 8.30 - 9.15 and 14.30 - 15.15 and at Corpus Christi Primary School between the hours of 08.30 - 09.30 and 14.30 - 15.30.
