Notice is hereby given that:

1. A by-election is to be held for the return of a COUNCILLOR for the following:

**Ward 8 – Southside Central**

**Ward 21 – North East**

The office is open for the issue and delivery of nomination papers on weekdays from **WEDNESDAY, 5 FEBRUARY 2025 from 10am to 4pm**.

3. Completed nomination papers must be delivered to the **Election Office, 40 John Street, Glasgow G1 1JL** no later than **4pm on MONDAY 17 FEBRUARY 2025**.
4. If the By-Election is contested, the poll will take place on **THURSDAY, 20 MARCH 2025 between 7am and 10pm**.
5. Any elector may apply for a postal or proxy vote at this election.

Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election, i.e. made after the <b>12<sup>th</sup> March 2025</b> deadline on the grounds of; disability suffered after that deadline (or, for applicants who suffered a disability before the deadline, their disability meant that they could not reasonably have made an application in time), work/service reasons, being detained in a hospital under the civil sections of the Mental Health (Care and Treatment) (Scotland) Act 2003 or for Scottish prisoners serving a sentence of 12 months or less, must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer at the address below <b>by 5pm on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> March 2025</b> . To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person <b>after 5pm on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> March 2025</b> .	5pm on Thursday 20 <sup>th</sup> March 2025
