

# Connecting Greater Govan



Glasgow City Council is in the planning stages of a new active travel network in the Greater Govan area. As part of the first phase of the City Network, Connecting Greater Govan aims to offer accessible and safe travel options for everyone.

This initiative would provide approximately 20km of high-quality cycling paths, enhanced pedestrian infrastructure, and public space improvements. The Council is progressing with the Yellow Package of Connecting Greater Govan, which includes the following routes:

- Skipness Drive (north), Moss Road, Peninver Drive, Burghead Place
- Skipness Drive (south), traffic-free path adjacent to A739
- Tormore Street, Berryknowes Road
- Langlands Road, Harmony Row, Burleigh Street, Water Row
- Arklet Road, Nimmo Drive, Craigton Road, Jura Street
- Dumbreck Road
