

PUBLIC PROCESSIONS COMMITTEE, 22 August 2019

The organiser had notified the council of its intention to carry out a procession, with around 300 participants, between Elder St and Craigton Rd at 19.30

After having heard M Miller, Head of Licensing and Democratic Services and Mr J O'Donnell, on behalf of the Organiser, that an agreement had been reached on an alternative route, in accordance with the recommendations as detailed in the report, the committee noted

(a) that the procession would proceed on Saturday, 30th August 2019;

(b) that the procession would start at 1900 hours, in order to comply with section 3.2 of the Council's Code of Conduct on Public Processions in relation to the timing of playing music; and

(c) that the Sean McIlvenna Republican Flute Band detailed on the Notification submitted by the Organiser would not to take any part in the Procession.
