

Glasgow City Council's Statutory Performance Indicators 2013-14

Background

Glasgow City Council reports every year on a set of performance indicators known as the Statutory Performance Indicators or SPIs.

They are part of the Local Government Benchmarking Framework (LGBF). The indicators included in the SPIs fall into these categories:

- Corporate Services
- Culture and Leisure Services
- Corporate Assets
- Economic Development

Our performance

The table shows the council's performance for 2013/14 on these indicators. It shows performance for the previous three years, the preferred trend and whether performance has improved. When comparing this year's performance with last year's, 7 indicators (78%) showed improvement but 2 (22%) showed a decline in performance.
