I've attached some of the written comms I've had with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] at RFC who has been my main point of contact as he was taking the lead on the Fan Zone from RFC perspective with some of his colleagues joining him at the Community Council meeting we all attended mid-July once we became aware of their objections to the Fanzone proposals.

Most of our comms had been about logistics & the overlay plans etc but these few emails are more general & the last is my informing [REDACTED] that their Fan Zone application would not be going to Licensing and G/Life would be withdrawing consent to use the venue following Councillor [REDACTED] & [REDACTED] meeting. Prior to that email, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] had called a Licensing Meeting for Mon 6th Aug during the Councils recess period to specifically discuss the RFC Fanzone application which I'd been asked to attend to represent G/Sport's stance. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] informed [REDACTED] on 2nd August (and cc'd me in) that following Councillor [REDACTED] & [REDACTED] meeting there was no need for that Licensing Meeting. I then spoke with [REDACTED] to let him know the Fanzone for 11th Aug would not be proceeding & followed that up with a more formal email withdrawing G/Life's approval for the time being.

Please accept my sincere apologies if my actions or emails have not been an accurate representation of what the company's position was on this one or are has played a significant part in this article being released, that was absolutely not my intention.
