Im not sure whether anyone has been in touch with you or your colleagues at RFC last night or this morning but I have been advised this morning that a decision was taken late last night by [REDACTED] and Cllr [REDACTED] that the Rangers fane zone proposal will not go forward to licensing for consideration.

Glasgow Life are therefore obliged to honour this decision, as such are unable to grant permission to use Ibrox Football Complex.

I also understand that the [REDACTED] has been advised of this decision.

The Licensing & Regulatory Committee meeting scheduled for Mon 6th Aug 2018 has therefore been cancelled.

Where this leaves us for the other 3 dates i dont 100% know but i suspect that with the Community Council objection still "live" for 6-months then there wont be much leeway until after the New Year. Hopefully by that time there will have been significant engagement from RFC with the local community and Councillors with a view to addressing some of the wider Match Day concerns they raised at the Community Council meeting last month. That groundwork may pave the way for a Fanzone at the tail end of the 2018/19 season?

I will keep you up to speed as/when i hear anything else on the matter from my superiors but you will need to cascade to [REDACTED] to put all plans on hold for install etc.

I'll call you next week as I'm on Annual Leave until Monday.
