Who are we?

We provide education for young people from across Scotland who are unable to attend school due to significant health needs.

We provide suitable, flexible education appropriate to their needs.

We are employed by GCC Education Department.

Where does teaching happen at HES?

At RHC:

- *There are classrooms in Ward 4 (Child Psychiatry Inpatient Unit) and Clinic 12*
- *Most teaching is on a 1:1 basis and takes place at the patient's bedside in individual rooms*
- *At RHC, teaching times are flexible to accommodate teachers moving throughout the hospital. There are strict infection control procedures which must be adhered to - these can affect whether or not pupils can be taught in small groups*

At Stobhill School:

- *There's a number of well-resourced classrooms for various subjects*
- *Class sizes are small and with 1:1 support, students can study targeted materials for their age and stage*
- *At Stobhill School, our day is divided into 7 periods*

What does teaching look like at HES?

Where appropriate, we support students to keep up-to-date with coursework and any other activities they would undertake in ideal circumstances at their base schools.

- *Our curriculum is designed to meet individual pupil needs*
- *We teach SQA coursework where possible and appropriate; we provide study support for subjects not currently taught at Stobhill School*
- *We may provide teaching up to Higher and Advanced Higher in subjects such as English and Maths*
- *We offer a range of Wider Achievement courses including Employability and Wellbeing, Duke of Edinburgh*
